The Probert Community Initiative Awards were first launched by Suffolk ACRE in 1999 in order to recognise the dedication, drive, enthusiasm and achievements of both individuals and organisations in Suffolk.

To mark its 70th anniversary, last year, Suffolk ACRE launched a brand new trophy, the **Campbell Cup** – named in honour of our long-serving Chairman, Ian Campbell – it was presented to the **individual** who made the most outstanding contribution to their community.

The **Probert Cup** was awarded to the **group** with the most outstanding community achievement. The Probert Cup consists of a series of Vs, which stand for Village Ventures, marking the origins of this award in recognising excellent community activities.

Following the success of having two cups, we will be continuing the process in 2008 and now is the time to put your thinking caps on and nominate those individuals or groups within your community who really make a difference.

All nominated groups/individuals will receive a certificate, with those short-listed receiving a framed certificate.

Short-listing will take place in July, judging in August, with the award presentation for those short-listed taking place at our AGM in September 2008.
